The Health, Physical Education, and Recreation (HPER) Department is excited to invite applicants for two, academic year nine-month tenure-track assistant professor positions beginning in August 2015.

The department seeks qualified exercise scientists to join our interdisciplinary team. Applicants trained in any field of exercise science will be given consideration, but those with a research emphasis in one of the following will be given preference: epidemiology of physical activity, sport/exercise psychology, or muscle physiology. Expectations for this position include teaching of undergraduate and/or graduate courses in the area of expertise and the maintenance of a focused and scholarly line of funded research and grant production.

The HPER Department <http://hper.usu.edu/> is in the Emma Eccles Jones College of Education and Human Services. The College is consistently ranked in the top tier of 1200 programs nationally by US News and World Report, with a current ranking of 24th overall and 4th in funded research. Within HPER, the exercise science program is well-equipped with laboratories in biomechanics and motion analysis, motor rehabilitation and learning, body composition and exercise physiology, sensory motor behavior, and a state-of-the-art sports medicine complex that includes computerized dynamic posturography and underwater treadmills.
